I am writing to thank you for successfully settling my New York State False Claims Act case.

When I came to the firm about my potential case I had a lot of questions and I was nervous about coming forward. I was a long time employee of the nursing home for whom I worked and I lost my job. I had some reservations about being a whistleblower and your team helped to ease my mind and assure me that it was the right thing to do.

The issues that were of concern to me involved the nursing home double-billing for residents beds even though they had left the facility permanently or for extended hospital stays. In some cases the residents had even passed away and the nursing home continued to bill Medicaid for the patient's beds.

After many years of observing this illegal activity and trying to make changes within the facility - I felt I had no choice but to formally report this to the government. Your firm explained all of the steps involved in filing my case, took the time to update me as it progressed, prepared me for my meeting with New York State officials, and patiently answered all of my questions along the way.

Without your knowledgeable guidance and representation, I may not have been successful in bringing this situation to the government's attention and achieving a just result.
